## SETTING THE MOON PHASE

Since the moon phase works on a 24 hour cycle, it is important to follow these steps to make sure the moon phase changes in step with the start of the new day at midnight.

1. Pull the crown out two positions to enter the hand setting mode. Then turn the hands past 12 o'clock until you see the moon shift forward. After reaching this point, continue moving the hands clockwise towards approximately 6 o'clock (any position between 4 and 8 will do).
2. Set the moon phase so that the moon is fully visible. To do this, push the crown two steps into the case (winding position), then pull it out one position and turn the crown anticlockwise until the moon completely fills the opening on the dial.

3. Using the table above, count the number of days since the last full moon to your current date. Then turn the crown so that the moon jumps the same number of times, one for each day that has passed since the last full moon. If you would prefer, you can also count from the new moon so that the watch will keep you vigilant of the notorious black moon phase.

4. When you are finished, set the time in the usual manner. Please bear in mind that since we turned the hands past midnight and stopped near 6 o'clock they are now in the AM period. If for instance the time is 7 PM, you must turn the hands past 12 noon, and then onwards to 7 o'clock. If you don't do this, your moon phase will change 12 hours later than it should.
